HEALTH OFFICE VISITS

- Students are not permitted to call a parent to be picked up if they are not feeling well
- Students must visit the nurse, and then the nurse will call home



HEALTH OFFICE VISITS

- YOU WILL BE CALLED TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP IF HE/SHE HAS A FEVER OF 100.4 OR ABOVE
- YOU WILL NOT ALWAYS RECEIVE A PHONE CALL EACH TIME YOUR CHILD VISITS THE NURSE
- STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CARRY MEDICATION TO AND FROM SCHOOL
- MEDICATION WILL BE GIVEN IN SCHOOL ONLY IF THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK IS FILED



IMMUNIZATIONS

- You will be notified if your child is missing any state mandated immunizations
- You will then have 30 days to get the vaccine or your student will be excluded
